### **Exhibitor Information**

**ENTRIES:** Pre-entries are highly recommended and pre-entries must be received by September 16. Entries can be faxed to (732) 361-3454 or mailed to Mary Norris 515 Fourth Ave, Avon by the Sea, NJ 07717. Entries will not be accepted by email. Post entry fee of \$15. No scratch fees, however, there will be a \$25 fee for horses schooled but not shown.

**COGGINS:** The State of Pennsylvania requires that all horses must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate (E.I.A.) dated within the previous 12 months. We will not accept or process any entry whose negative Coggins Certificate, or copy thereof, does not accompany the horse. The show may retain a copy for its records. No numbers will be issued without a coggins certificate.

Snowbird Acres Farm, Claudine Liberatore, North Ridge Farms LLC, or anyone on the show committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss, or damage at the show.

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED IS RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SPECS OF CURRENT USEF RULES AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

**SCHEDULE:** The committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, move, or substitute classes at their discretion.

**PARKING:** There will be separate parking for cars and trailers. Parking attendants will be available to ensure proper placement of vehicles.

**PETS:** Please keep pets on a leash. No exceptions. Any pet that disrupts the performance of a horse in the show ring will pay double the entry fee for that class.

**JUMP ORDERS:** Jump orders will be established at the gate with the starter. All classes with at least \$1,000 in prize money will have posted orders. Orders will be made available at least one hour before start of class and posted at both the show office and the ingate. Any entries made after the order is posted will go to the top of the order.

**SCHOOLING:** All horses must school with a back number.

Main Ring Saturday 6 AM- 7:30 AM & as scheduled during day: schooling over fences permitted  
Annex Ring Saturday 6 AM-7:45 AM & as scheduled during day: schooling over fences permitted  
Main Ring Sunday 6:30 AM- 7:30 AM: flatwork only

**HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIPS** will be awarded in accordance with USEF Rule HU 148.

**LUNGING:** Lunging will be permitted in the covered roundpen and at specified locations during the show day. There will be no lunging in any show ring at any time.

**RING INFORMATION:**

Main Ring 130 x 280 Screenings  
Indoor Ring 80 x 184 Screenings and Rubber  
Sand Ring 60 x 120 Sand and Rubber

**FEES:** A \$20 fee will be charged to cover EMT, Grounds, and Office Fees. Any non-negotiable checks will be charged a \$100 collections fee. All entries not paid at the horse show will incur a \$25 late payment fee.

**SHARPS CONTAINERS** will be located at the show office.

**HUNTERS** will be judged on performance, soundness, and manners.

**HUNTER JUMPER COURSES** may include gates, walls, bushes, oxers, panels,coops,logs, and combinations.

**MEASUREMENTS:** All measurements will be the responsibility of the horse show when made by appointment. Measurements taken at any other time will be available at the exhibitor's expense.

**TIES** other than for first place will remain tied.

**ADDITIONAL RULES:** Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges or Officials on the part of any owner, rider, driver, trainer or groom may disqualify the horse, and the owner will forfeit all entry and other fees. The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse and to remove any horse or groom from the Show without being liable for compensation. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, trainer, groom or attendant, animal, carriage or equipment at the Show. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final. No person(s) suspended by USEF will be allowed on premises.

**PRIZE MONEY:** All prize money will be paid through the Show Office. Prize monies will be deducted from horse show bills. No prize monies will be mailed.

**RIDER AGE:** as of December 1 of the current show year.

**HELMETS:** All riders and exhibitors must wear USEF approved (ASTM/SEI) headgear at all times while mounted.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parents, legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parents, guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT** Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions, 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with Adult and/or Pony Medal. Fences 3'

15. M&S Adult Medal- Fence Height: 3'

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. No cross entry restrictions. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Pony Medal. Fences 3'

30. M&S Children's Pony Medal

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional, and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal or Children's 2'6" Medal at the same show. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Adult Medal. Fences 2'6" (Large) Fences 2'0" (Sm/Med).

40. M&S 2'6" Children's Medal

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May ONLY be combined with M&S 2'6" Adult Medal. Fences 2'6"

45. M&S 2'6" Adult Medal

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to Adult Riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences 3' or higher. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. May ONLY be combined with M&S 2'6" Children's Medal. Fences 2'6"

59. Leadline

Entry Fee: \$10

Open to riders 6 years and under. To be judged on equitation at a walk with a lead. No additional fees charged to entries who shown only in leadline
